ER Quicker

Persons seeking medical help won't have to wait in the emergency room at Palm Beach Gardens Medical Center because of a new service through In-QuickerER,

The medical center said patients pay a fee, complete an online form, wait at home and arrive at the projected treatment time when a health professional in the emergency room will be available within 15 minutes, or In-QuickerER will refund the online fee in full. The new service is only intended for individuals who have non-life threatening medical conditions.

"We know people want more convenience and communication in the ER experience," said Dr. David Katzin, chief medical officer, Tenet Florida, adding: "Lowering the time spent in an ER may reduce exposure to some infections spreading in the waiting room."

Individuals requiring immediate medical treatment should go immediately to the nearest emergency department or call 911, Katzin said.
